EAGLE: Some of the most significant results

- Communication about ionizing radiation **is still too much seen as a one-directional transfer of information** from a source to a receiver.
- There is **a big difference between the public perception and intentions of those who are providing information** on IR risk.
- Communication by users of IR is mainly **inspired by the idea that the general public should be 'educated'** by 'explaining them the facts' and by assisting people to 'better understand' nuclear technology.
- **Citizens miss the recognition** by an industry and research **of being a competent stakeholder**.
- **Mutual learning and transparency** by all stakeholders is required.....

Significant amount of research, knowledge and information gained, discussed within larger community (RICOMET), agreement on appropriate approaches, recommendations developed,...

From research to practice

- Not only generating ideas for new research, but putting new knowledge into practice.
- Better and direct use / exploitation of project results (new recognitions, studies, recommendations, guidelines,...) in practice in order to achieve positive changes in real life, gain experiences and additional knowledge.
