What did we learn?



- Many actors are using social media in a variety of ways
 - Crisis communication
 - Research
 - General communication about radiation
 - Open access to data, data sharing
 - Crowdsourcing
 - Discussion forums
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Ethical issues (private, public, professional, ...)





- Representativeness either of the sample studied or the populations reached
- Potential for manipulation, propaganda, creating anxiety, ...
