





Biological dosimetry in Europe is it necessary according emergency responding authorities?



What is the biological dosimetry?









□ Biological dosimetry is accepted by IAEA and European Commission as a important part of response for the radiological emergency.

□ Is present in almost all European countries, but sometimes without adequate financial support from emergency responding authorities.

□ Nobody wish biological dosimetry methods to be ever used and in fact these methods are used rather seldom. Unfortunately that prompt the emergency responding authorities not to give money for biological dosimetry, but e.g. propose that there are money for real work.

□ Unfortunately it is not acceptable as the maintenance of trained people and equipment cost a lot but it is not possible to organize biological dosimetry laboratory within days or months.
